3 **SECTION 1. SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR DIS-**
4 **ASTER RELIEF RELATED TO HURRICANE HE-**
5 **LENE.**

6 In addition to amounts otherwise available, there is
7 appropriated, out of any money in the Treasury not other-
8 wise appropriated—

9 (1) \$10,000,000,000 to the Administrator of
10 the Federal Emergency Management Agency to pro-

1 vide assistance under the Robert T. Stafford Dis-
2 aster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42
3 U.S.C. 5121 et seq.) in response to Hurricane He-
4 lene; and

5 (2) \$5,000,000,000 to the Secretary of Housing
6 and Urban Development to provide assistance under
7 title I of the Housing and Community Development
8 Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5301 et seq.) related to dis-
9 aster relief for Hurricane Helene.
