4 **TO PRESENT CONGRESSIONAL GOLD MEDAL**
5 **TO WORLD WAR II MEMBERS OF DOOLITTLE**
6 **TOKYO RAIDERS.**

7 Emancipation Hall in the Capitol Visitor Center is
8 authorized to be used on April 15, 2015, for a ceremony

1 to present the Congressional Gold Medal to the World War
2 II members of the Doolittle Tokyo Raiders collectively, in
3 recognition of the military service and exemplary record
4 of the Doolittle Tokyo Raiders during World War II.
5 Physical preparations for the conduct of the ceremony
6 shall be carried out in accordance with such conditions as
7 the Architect of the Capitol may prescribe.
