Mr. BARLETTA (for himself and Ms. NORTON) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for the National
Honor Guard and Pipe Band Exhibition.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF THE CAPITOL GROUNDS FOR NA-**
4 **TIONAL HONOR GUARD AND PIPE BAND EX-**
5 **HIBITION.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Grand Lodge of the Fra-
7 ternal Order of Police and its auxiliary (in this resolution
8 referred to as the “sponsor”) shall be permitted to sponsor
9 a public event, the National Honor Guard and Pipe Band
10 Exhibition (in this resolution referred to as the “event”),

1 on the Capitol Grounds, in order to allow law enforcement
2 representatives to exhibit their ability to demonstrate
3 Honor Guard programs and provide for a bag pipe exhi-
4 bition.

5 (b) DATE OF EVENT.—The event shall be held on
6 May 14, 2013, or on such other date as the Speaker of
7 the House of Representatives and the Committee on Rules
8 and Administration of the Senate jointly designate.

9 **SEC. 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**

10 (a) IN GENERAL.—Under conditions to be prescribed
11 by the Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
12 Board, the event shall be—

13 (1) free of admission charge and open to the
14 public; and

15 (2) arranged not to interfere with the needs of
16 Congress.

17 (b) EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES.—The sponsor shall
18 assume full responsibility for all expenses and liabilities
19 incident to all activities associated with the event.

20 **SEC. 3. EVENT PREPARATIONS.**

21 Subject to the approval of the Architect of the Cap-
22 itol, the sponsor is authorized to erect upon the Capitol
23 Grounds such stage, sound amplification devices, and
24 other related structures and equipment, as may be re-
25 quired for the event.

1 **SEC. 4. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.**

2 The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-
3 ment of the restrictions contained in section 5104(c) of
4 title 40, United States Code, concerning sales, advertise-
5 ments, displays, and solicitations on the Capitol Grounds,
6 as well as other restrictions applicable to the Capitol
7 Grounds, in connection with the event.

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
