5 Capitol Visitor Center is authorized to be used on March
6 21, 2024, for a ceremony to present the Congressional
7 Gold Medal collectively to the 23d Headquarters Special
8 Troops and the 3133d Signal Services Company, known
9 collectively as the “Ghost Army”, in recognition of unique
10 and highly distinguished service during World War II.

11 (b) **PREPARATIONS.**—Physical preparations for the
12 conduct of the ceremony described in subsection (a) shall
13 be carried out in accordance with such conditions as the
14 Architect of the Capitol may prescribe.
