JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for the appointment of John Fahey as a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That, in accordance with section 5581 of the Revised Stat-
4 utes (20 U.S.C. 43), the vacancy on the Board of Regents
5 of the Smithsonian Institution, in the class other than
6 Members of Congress, occurring by reason of the expira-
7 tion of the term of Roger W. Sant of the District of Co-
8 lumbia on October 24, 2013, is filled by the appointment
9 of John Fahey of the District of Columbia. The appoint-

1 ment is for a term of 6 years, beginning on the date of
2 the enactment of this joint resolution.
