- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
- 8 States within seven years after the date of its submission
- 9 for ratification:

"ARTICLE —

2 "SECTION 1. All persons shall enjoy the right to3 health care of equal high quality.

4 "SECTION 2. The Congress shall have power to en5 force and implement this article by appropriate legisla6 tion.".
