JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed direct commercial sale to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia of certain weaponry and munitions.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the issuance of a license for the export with respect
4 to any of the following transfers to the Kingdom of Saudi
5 Arabia is prohibited:

6 (1) The transfer of the following defense arti-
7 cles, described in license document DDTC 20–11,
8 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(e) of
9 the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(e))

1 on November 4, 2021: The proposed transfer of two
2 hundred eighty (280) AIM-120C-7/C-8 Advanced
3 Medium Range Air-to-Air Missiles (AMRAAM) and
4 five hundred ninety-six (596) LAU-128 Missile Rail
5 Launchers (MRL); containers; weapon support and
6 support equipment; spare and repair parts; U.S.
7 Government and contractor engineering, technical
8 and logistical support services; and other related ele-
9 ments of logistical and program support.
