- 3 That the issuance of a manufacturing license, technical
- 4 assistance license, or export license with respect to any
- 5 of the following proposed agreements or transfers to the
- 6 Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, the United Kingdom of Great

1 Britain and Northern Ireland, the Kingdom of Spain, and  
2 the Italian Republic is prohibited:

3 (1) The transfer of the following defense arti-  
4 cles, including defense services and technical data,  
5 described in license document DDTC-17-094 as  
6 designated by the Department of State pursuant to  
7 the Arms Export Control Act:

8 (A) Coproduction and manufacture in  
9 Saudi Arabia of Paveway Pre-Amp Circuit Card  
10 Assemblies (CCA), Guidance Electronics As-  
11 sembly (GEA) CCAs, and Control Actuator  
12 System (CAS) CCAs for all Paveway variants.

13 (B) Coproduction and manufacture in  
14 Saudi Arabia of Paveway II Guidance Elec-  
15 tronics Detector Assemblies (GEDA) and Com-  
16 puter Control Groups (CCG).

17 (C) The transfer of up to 64,603 addi-  
18 tional kits, partial kits, and full-up-rounds.
