## RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to deny certain privileges of the House of Representatives to former Members who have been expelled from the House, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

3 This resolution may be cited as the “Upholding the

4 Integrity of Our Institution Resolution”.

1 **SEC. 2. DENYING ADMISSION TO HALL OF THE HOUSE TO**  
2 **FORMER MEMBERS WHO HAVE BEEN EX-**  
3 **PELLED.**

4 Clause 4(a) of rule IV of the Rules of the House of  
5 Representatives is amended—

6 (1) by striking “or” at the end of subparagraph  
7 (3);

8 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-  
9 paragraph (4) and inserting “; or”; and

10 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
11 paragraph:

12 “(5) has been expelled from the House.”.

13 **SEC. 3. BENEFITS AND SERVICES PROVIDED TO CERTAIN**  
14 **FORMER MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF REP-**  
15 **RESENTATIVES.**

16 Rule XXIX of the Rules of the House of Representa-  
17 tives is amended by adding at the end the following new  
18 clause:

19 “5. In the case of a former Member, Delegate, or  
20 Resident Commissioner who has been expelled from the  
21 House of Representatives, such Member, Delegate, or  
22 Resident Commissioner may not retain possession of a  
23 Member pin after such expulsion and no benefit or service  
24 of the House shall be made available to such former Mem-  
25 ber, Delegate, or Resident Commissioner, including any of  
26 the following:

1           “(a) Access to the floor of the House.

2           “(b) Access to athletic facilities and other facili-  
3 ties available for the use of Members of the House.

4           “(c) Access to the Members’ Dining Room lo-  
5 cated in the House of Representatives wing of the  
6 United States Capitol.

7           “(d) Access to parking spaces.

8           “(e) Access to material from the House docu-  
9 ment room.

10          “(f) Use of the collections in the House Legisla-  
11 tive Resource Center without borrowing privileges.

12          “(g) Short-term franking privileges.

13          “(h) Access to materials through the Congres-  
14 sional Research Service and the Library of Con-  
15 gress.”.
