RESOLUTION

Condemning Iran's unprecedented drone and missile attack
on Israel.

Whereas, beginning on April 13, 2024, Iran for the first time ever launched a direct attack on Israel that included over 350 missiles and drones launched directly from Iran and its proxies toward Israel;

Whereas this direct attack on Israel followed: Iran-backed Hamas' massive, unprovoked attack on Israel on October

7 that killed over 1,200 people; months of cross-border
 attacks from Iran-backed Hezbollah into Israel from Leb-
 anon; over 170 attacks on United States troops in the
 Middle East by Iran-backed militias since October; and
 months of Iran-backed Houthi missile and drone attacks
 on global shipping;

Whereas 99 percent of the projectiles fired at Israel were
 intercepted by Israel, the United States, the United
 Kingdom, France, and Jordan, minimizing casualties and
 other damage from this unprecedented, brazen attack by
 Iran;

Whereas Israel intercepted these missiles and drones using a
 variety of air defense systems and other defense articles,
 including many procured from or co-produced with the
 United States, demonstrating the vital importance of the
 United States and Israel's security partnership; and

Whereas Israel is a major non-NATO ally and Major Stra-
 tegic Partner of the United States: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—

2 (1) condemns Iran's unprecedented drone and
 3 missile attack on Israel;

4 (2) reaffirms and supports Israel's right to self-
 5 defense;

6 (3) stands with Israel as it defends itself
 7 against Iran's attack and seeks to re-establish deter-
 8 rence against Iran and its proxies;

9 (4) fully supports Israel's right to respond to
 10 this aggression through military, diplomatic, eco-
 11 nomic, and other necessary means;

1 (5) calls on all countries to unequivocally con-
2 demn Iran’s attack on Israel;

3 (6) commends the United States military, the
4 United Kingdom, France, and Jordan for inter-
5 cepting Iranian missiles and drones and thereby lim-
6 iting the damage from this unprecedented attack on
7 Israel;

8 (7) reaffirms the United States commitment to
9 Israel’s security, including through security assist-
10 ance and defense sales;

11 (8) urges full enforcement of United States
12 sanctions and export controls against Iran to impede
13 Iran’s nuclear program, missile and drone develop-
14 ment, and funding of terrorist groups and proxies,
15 including Hezbollah, Hamas and Palestine Islamic
16 Jihad, the Houthis, and militias in Iraq and Syria;
17 and

18 (9) stands ready to assist Israel with emergency
19 resupply and other security, diplomatic, and intel-
20 ligence support.
