## RESOLUTION

Prohibiting Members of the House of Representatives from bringing or displaying a flag of a foreign nation on the floor of the House, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved,*

2       **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION WITH RESPECT TO FLAG OF A**  
3                       **FOREIGN NATION ON THE FLOOR OF THE**  
4                       **HOUSE.**

5       (a) PROHIBITION.—

1           (1) IN GENERAL.—During a session of the  
2 House of Representatives, a Member, Delegate, or  
3 Resident Commissioner may not bring or display on  
4 the floor of the House any flag of a foreign nation.

5           (2) APPLICATION.—Except as provided under  
6 subsection (b), the prohibition under subsection (a)  
7 shall apply to a flag of a foreign nation regardless  
8 of the size of the flag.

9           (b) EXCEPTION.—The prohibition under subsection  
10 (a) shall not apply—

11           (1) to a flag of a foreign nation worn as a lapel  
12 pin by a Member, Delegate, or Resident Commis-  
13 sioner; or

14           (2) to a depiction of a flag of a foreign nation  
15 used as part of an exhibit by a Member, Delegate,  
16 or Resident Commissioner during a speech or debate  
17 under the Rules of the House of Representatives.

18           (c) ENFORCEMENT.—The Sergeant-at-Arms of the  
19 House of Representatives is charged with the enforcement  
20 of the prohibition under subsection (a).
