For the expenses of the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform (hereafter in this resolution referred to as the "Committee"), including the expenses of all staff salaries, there shall be paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House of Representatives for committee salaries and expenses, not more than \$21,226,108 for the One Hundred Twelfth Congress.

- 3 (1) not more than \$10,613,054 shall be avail4 able for expenses incurred during the period begin5 ning at noon on January 3, 2011, and ending imme6 diately before noon on January 3, 2012; and
- 7 (2) not more than \$10,613,054 shall be avail8 able for expenses incurred during the period begin9 ning at noon on January 3, 2012, and ending imme10 diately before noon on January 3, 2013.

11 SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.

vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
directed by the Committee on House Administration.

16 SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.
