RESOLUTION

Directing the Secretary of Homeland Security to transmit to the House of Representatives not later than 7 days after the date of the adoption of this resolution all documents, records, and communications in the possession of the Secretary of Homeland Security relating to the July 13, 2024, attempted assassination of former President Donald J. Trump, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That the Secretary of Homeland Security
2 is directed to transmit to the House of Representatives,
3 not later than 7 days after the date of the adoption of
4 this resolution, copies of any document, memorandum,

1 correspondence, and other communication or any portion
2 of any such communication, that refers or relates to the
3 July 13, 2024, attempted assassination of former Presi-
4 dent Donald J. Trump, including the following:

5 (1) All documents and communications relating
6 to United States Secret Service protection for
7 former President Donald J. Trump’s campaign in
8 Butler, Pennsylvania, on July 13, 2024.

9 (2) All documents and communications, includ-
10 ing text messages and email communications, be-
11 tween and among, the United States Secret Service
12 and the Department of Homeland Security related
13 to former President Donald J. Trump’s campaign
14 rally in Butler, Pennsylvania, on July 13, 2024.

15 (3) All audio and video recordings in the United
16 States Secret Service’s possession or custody related
17 to former President Donald J. Trump’s campaign
18 rally in Butler, Pennsylvania, on July 13, 2024.
