Mr. KILMER (for himself, Mr. MORELLE, and Mr. CAREY) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

RESOLUTION

Establishing the Congressional Modernization Competition, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*,

2 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

3 This resolution may be cited as the “Congressional
4 Modernization Competition Resolution of 2024”.

5 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

6 The House of Representatives finds the following:

7 (1) The House of Representatives was designed
8 to be the representative branch of government closest
9 to the people.

1 (2) The House of Representatives must contin-
2 ually assess its capacity to fulfill its constitutional
3 responsibilities.

4 (3) Civic education and citizen participation are
5 vital components to the continued health of our de-
6 mocracy.

7 (4) Research shows that participation in civic
8 life at an early age allows students to build interest
9 and skillsets that will keep them engaged citizens
10 throughout their lives.

11 (5) Ideas to modernize Congress can and should
12 come from Americans of different ages, back-
13 grounds, and walks of life.

14 (6) It is therefore appropriate for the House of
15 Representatives to institute a new competition to
16 both encourage students' participation in civic life,
17 while providing Congress with additional rec-
18 ommendations to modernize and improve its work.

19 **SEC. 3. CONGRESSIONAL COMPETITION IN EFFECTIVE-**
20 **NESS, EFFICIENCY, AND TRANSPARENCY.**

21 (a) ESTABLISHMENT OF COMPETITION.—There is
22 hereby established an academic competition for the pur-
23 poses of developing ideas for increasing the effectiveness,
24 efficiency, and transparency of the operations of the

1 House of Representatives which shall be held each year
2 among students in each congressional district.

3 (b) REGULATIONS.—The competition under this sub-
4 section (a) shall be carried out in accordance with such
5 regulations as may be prescribed by the Committee on
6 House Administration, except that the regulations shall
7 permit the office of a Member to seek guidance from out-
8 side experts in the fields of government, political science,
9 and civics education for the purposes of establishing cri-
10 teria for the selection of competition judges and for the
11 judgment of competition submissions.
