RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1076) to prohibit Federal funding of National Public Radio and the use of Federal funds to acquire radio content.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 1076) to prohibit Federal funding of National Public
4 Radio and the use of Federal funds to acquire radio con-
5 tent. All points of order against consideration of the bill
6 are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points
7 of order against provisions in the bill are waived. The pre-

1 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
2 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
3 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair
4 and ranking minority member of the Committee on En-
5 ergy and Commerce; and (2) one motion to recommit.
