RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives with respect to the nomination of Neil Gorsuch to the Supreme Court.

Whereas the Supreme Court has had a vacant seat since the death of Justice Antonin Scalia;

Whereas Neil Gorsuch is a defender of the intrinsic value of human life;

Whereas Neil Gorsuch is a defender of religious liberty;

Whereas Neil Gorsuch is a constitutional conservative who will honor the ideals of our Founding Fathers; and

Whereas Neil Gorsuch was previously nominated to the Tenth Circuit Court of Appeals and confirmed by the Senate unanimously: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the House of Rep-
2 representatives that—

3 (1) the House firmly supports the nomination
4 of Neil Gorsuch to the Supreme Court; and

5 (2) the Senate should hold a swift confirmation
6 of this nomination.
