Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1062) to improve the consideration by the Securities and Exchange Commission of the costs and benefits of its regulations and orders.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1062) to improve the consideration
6 by the Securities and Exchange Commission of the costs

1 and benefits of its regulations and orders. The first read-
2 ing of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
3 against consideration of the bill are waived. General de-
4 bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one
5 hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and rank-
6 ing minority member of the Committee on Financial Serv-
7 ices. After general debate the bill shall be considered for
8 amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order
9 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-
10 ment under the five-minute rule an amendment in the na-
11 ture of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Com-
12 mittee Print 113-10. That amendment in the nature of
13 a substitute shall be considered as read. All points of order
14 against that amendment in the nature of a substitute are
15 waived. No amendment to that amendment in the nature
16 of a substitute shall be in order except those printed in
17 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
18 resolution. Each such amendment may be offered only in
19 the order printed in the report, may be offered only by
20 a Member designated in the report, shall be considered
21 as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the
22 report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
23 an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
24 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
25 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points

1 of order against such amendments are waived. At the con-
2 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
3 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
4 such amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member
5 may demand a separate vote in the House on any amend-
6 ment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill
7 or to the amendment in the nature of a substitute made
8 in order as original text. The previous question shall be
9 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto
10 to final passage without intervening motion except one
11 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
