RESOLUTION

Of inquiry requesting the President to provide certain documents in his possession to the House of Representatives relating to the Environmental Protection Agency's April proposed finding that greenhouse gas emissions are a danger to public health and welfare.

1 *Resolved*, That the President is requested to furnish
2 the House of Representatives, not later than 14 days after
3 the adoption of this resolution, all documents, including
4 telephone and electronic mail records, logs and calendars,
5 and records of internal discussions in his possession pro-
6 duced by the Administrator of the Environmental Protec-

1 tion Agency or the Director of the Office of Management
2 and Budget, relating to the following:

3 (1) The untitled, undated memo marked “De-
4 liberative—Attorney Client Privilege”, which begins
5 “The NPRM fails to articulate the process by which
6 the Administrator came to the conclusion on p. 30”.

7 (2) Interagency comments or documents related
8 to the Environmental Protection Agency’s April pro-
9 posed finding that greenhouse gas emissions are a
10 danger to public health and welfare.

11 (3) Cost benefit or systematic risk analysis re-
12 lated to the Environmental Protection Agency’s
13 April proposed finding that greenhouse gas emis-
14 sions are a danger to public health and welfare.

15 (4) Scientific evidence that demonstrates health
16 effects of greenhouse gases.
