RESOLUTION

Prohibiting Members of the House of Representatives from bringing or displaying a flag of a foreign nation on the floor of the House, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved,*

2 PROHIBITION WITH RESPECT TO FLAG OF A FOREIGN

3 NATION ON THE FLOOR OF THE HOUSE

4 SECTION 1.

5 (a) PROHIBITION.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—During a session of the

7 House of Representatives, a Member, Delegate, or

1 Resident Commissioner may not bring or display on
2 the floor of the House any flag of a foreign nation.

3 (2) APPLICATION.—Except as provided under
4 subsection (b), the prohibition under subsection (a)
5 shall apply to a flag of a foreign nation regardless
6 of the size of the flag.

7 (b) EXCEPTION.—The prohibition under subsection
8 (a) shall not apply—

9 (1) to a flag of a foreign nation worn as a lapel
10 pin by a Member, Delegate, or Resident Commis-
11 sioner; or

12 (2) to a depiction of a flag of a foreign nation
13 used as part of an exhibit by a Member, Delegate,
14 or Resident Commissioner during a speech or debate
15 under the Rules of the House of Representatives.

16 (c) ENFORCEMENT.—The Sergeant-at-Arms of the
17 House of Representatives is charged with the enforcement
18 of the prohibition under subsection (a).
