Mr. WOODALL, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 71) establishing the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2018 and setting forth the appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2019 through 2027.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-  
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule  
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of  
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 71) estab-

1 lishing the congressional budget for the United States  
2 Government for fiscal year 2018 and setting forth the ap-  
3 propriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2019 through  
4 2027. The first reading of the concurrent resolution shall  
5 be dispensed with. All points of order against consider-  
6 ation of the concurrent resolution are waived. General de-  
7 bate shall not exceed four hours, with three hours of gen-  
8 eral debate confined to the congressional budget equally  
9 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority  
10 member of the Committee on the Budget and one hour  
11 of general debate on the subject of economic goals and  
12 policies equally divided and controlled by Representative  
13 Tiberi of Ohio and Representative Carolyn Maloney of  
14 New York or their respective designees. After general de-  
15 bate the concurrent resolution shall be considered for  
16 amendment under the five-minute rule. The concurrent  
17 resolution shall be considered as read. No amendment  
18 shall be in order except those printed in the report of the  
19 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each  
20 such amendment may be offered only in the order printed  
21 in the report, may be offered only by a Member designated  
22 in the report, shall be considered as read, and shall be  
23 debatable for the time specified in the report equally di-  
24 vided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent.  
25 All points of order against such amendments are waived

1 except that the adoption of an amendment in the nature  
2 of a substitute shall constitute the conclusion of consider-  
3 ation of the concurrent resolution for amendment. After  
4 the conclusion of consideration of the concurrent resolu-  
5 tion for amendment and a final period of general debate,  
6 which shall not exceed 10 minutes equally divided and con-  
7 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the  
8 Committee on the Budget, the Committee shall rise and  
9 report the concurrent resolution to the House with such  
10 amendment as may have been adopted. The previous ques-  
11 tion shall be considered as ordered on the concurrent reso-  
12 lution and amendments thereto to adoption without inter-  
13 vening motion except amendments offered by the chair of  
14 the Committee on the Budget pursuant to section  
15 305(a)(5) of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 to  
16 achieve mathematical consistency. The concurrent resolu-  
17 tion shall not be subject to a demand for division of the  
18 question of its adoption.
