RESOLUTION

Recognizing Interscholastic Athletic Administrators' Day on
December 14, 2021.

Whereas, each December, we recognize the positive contribu-
tions of interscholastic athletic administrators;

Whereas the position of school athletic administrator is recog-
nized as a profession, which, like other academic profes-
sions, benefits greatly from continued education and cer-
tification;

Whereas school athletic programs develop young people phys-
ically, mentally, socially, and emotionally by the life les-
sons learned through participation and competition;

Whereas interscholastic athletic participation is an integral
part of a student's educational experience and enhances
the learning and maturation process;

Whereas athletic administrators are committed to developing and maintaining comprehensive education-based athletic programs which seek the highest development of all student athletes;

Whereas athletic administrators fulfill professional responsibilities with integrity, commitment to equality, industriousness to long hours, and fairness;

Whereas athletic administrators preserve, enhance, and promote the educational values of athletics in our schools through professional growth in the areas of education, leadership, and service;

Whereas athletic administrators embody high standards of ethics, sportsmanship, and personal conduct, and encourage coaching staffs, student athletes, and community members to commit to these high standards as well;

Whereas, during the COVID–19 pandemic, athletic administrators continue to be at the forefront of developing and implementing safety practices, exhibiting wisdom in preparation, adaptation, change, and collaboration; and

Whereas the athletic programs run by these administrators have impacts that extend well beyond the playing field, athletic venues, and even the school: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—

2 (1) supports the annual recognition of Inter-
3 scholastic Athletic Administrators’ Day;

4 (2) commends athletic administrators for their
5 commitment and leadership provided to student ath-
6 letes at the secondary school level; and

1 (3) commends the National Interscholastic Ath-
2 letic Administrators Association as the leading orga-
3 nization that prepares those who lead secondary
4 school athletics throughout the country, providing
5 continuous learning, compassion, and preparation
6 within the profession.
