Mr. COLLINS of Georgia, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

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## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6237) to authorize appropriations for fiscal years 2018 and 2019 for intelligence and intelligence-related activities of the United States Government, the Community Management Account, and the Central Intelligence Agency Retirement and Disability System, and for other purposes.

- 1       *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-
- 2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
- 3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of

1 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 6237) to authorize appropriations  
3 for fiscal years 2018 and 2019 for intelligence and intel-  
4 ligence-related activities of the United States Government,  
5 the Community Management Account, and the Central In-  
6 telligence Agency Retirement and Disability System, and  
7 for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be  
8 dispensed with. All points of order against consideration  
9 of the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined  
10 to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided  
11 and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member  
12 of the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence. After  
13 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment  
14 under the five-minute rule. In lieu of the amendment in  
15 the nature of a substitute recommended by the Permanent  
16 Select Committee on Intelligence now printed in the bill,  
17 it shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the  
18 purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule an  
19 amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the  
20 text of Rules Committee Print 115-80. That amendment  
21 in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read.  
22 All points of order against that amendment in the nature  
23 of a substitute are waived. No amendment to that amend-  
24 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except  
25 those printed in the report of the Committee on Rules ac-

1 accompanying this resolution. Each such amendment may  
2 be offered only in the order printed in the report, may  
3 be offered only by a Member designated in the report,  
4 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time  
5 specified in the report equally divided and controlled by  
6 the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to  
7 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-  
8 sion of the question in the House or in the Committee  
9 of the Whole. All points of order against such amendments  
10 are waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill  
11 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the  
12 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been  
13 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the  
14 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of  
15 the Whole to the bill or to the amendment in the nature  
16 of a substitute made in order as original text. The previous  
17 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and  
18 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening  
19 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-  
20 structions.

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
