Mr. SCHATZ (for himself, Mr. BARRASSO, Mr. TESTER, and Ms. HIRONO) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Indian Affairs

A BILL

To clarify certain provisions of the Native American Veterans' Memorial Establishment Act of 1994.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Native American Vet-
5 erans’ Memorial Amendments Act of 2013”.

6 **SEC. 2. NATIVE AMERICAN VETERANS’ MEMORIAL.**

7 (a) **AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH MEMORIAL.**—Section
8 3 of the Native American Veterans’ Memorial Establish-
9 ment Act of 1994 (20 U.S.C. 80q–5 note; 108 Stat. 4067)
10 is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (b), by striking “within the in-
2 terior structure of the facility” and inserting “on the
3 property”; and

4 (2) in subsection (c)(1), by striking “, in con-
5 sultation with the Museum, is” and inserting “and
6 the National Museum of the American Indian are”.

7 (b) PAYMENT OF EXPENSES.—Section 4(a) of the
8 Native American Veterans’ Memorial Establishment Act
9 of 1994 (20 U.S.C. 80q–5 note; 108 Stat. 4067) is amend-
10 ed—

11 (1) in the heading, by inserting “AND NA-
12 TIONAL MUSEUM OF THE AMERICAN INDIAN ” after
13 “AMERICAN INDIANS ”; and

14 (2) in the first sentence, by striking “shall be
15 solely” and inserting “and the National Museum of
16 the American Indian shall be”.
