AN ACT

To adjust the boundary of Big Bend National Park in the State of Texas, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Big Bend National3 Park Boundary Adjustment Act".

4 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

5 In this Act:

6 (1) MAP.—The term "map" means the map en7 titled "Big Bend National Park, Proposed Boundary
8 Adjustment", numbered 155/167,296, and dated
9 November 2022.

10 (2) PARK.—The term "Park" means the Big
11 Bend National Park established under the Act of
12 June 20, 1935 (49 Stat. 393, chapter 283; 16
13 U.S.C. 156).

14 (3) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means15 the Secretary of the Interior.

16 SEC. 3. BIG BEND NATIONAL PARK BOUNDARY ADJUST17 MENT.

(a) LAND ACQUISITION.—The Secretary may acquire
approximately 6,100 acres of land or interests in land generally depicted on the map as "Tracts to Include in
Boundary" by donation, purchase from willing sellers, or
exchange.

(b) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The map shall be on file
and available for public inspection in the appropriate offices of the National Park Service.

(c) BOUNDARY REVISION AND ADMINISTRATION.—
 On acquisition of any land or interests in land under sub section (a), the Secretary shall—

- 4 (1) revise the boundary of the Park to include5 the acquired land or interests in land; and
- 6 (2) administer the acquired land or interests in
 7 land as part of the Park in accordance with applica8 ble laws (including regulations).

9 (d) EMINENT DOMAIN OR CONDEMNATION.—In car10 rying out this Act, the Secretary may not use eminent do11 main or condemnation.
