A BILL

To maintain the National Coal Council in the Department of Energy to provide advice and recommendations to the Secretary of Energy on matters relating to coal and the coal industry, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Coal Council Certainty
5 Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL COAL COUNCIL.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Energy shall
3 maintain the National Coal Council, in accordance with
4 the charter for the National Coal Council (as filed with
5 Congress on November 19, 2021).

6 (b) APPLICABILITY OF THE FEDERAL ADVISORY
7 COMMITTEE ACT.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraph (2),
9 the Federal Advisory Committee Act (5 U.S.C.
10 App.) shall apply to the National Coal Council.

11 (2) TERMINATION.—Section 14 of the Federal
12 Advisory Committee Act (5 U.S.C. App.) shall not
13 apply to the National Coal Council.
