## A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to facilitate emergency medical services personnel training and certification curriculums for military veterans.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans to Para-
- 5 medics Transition Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. GRANTS FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PER-
- 7 SONNEL TRAINING FOR VETERANS.
- 8 Section 330J(c)(8) of the Public Health Service Act
- 9 (42 U.S.C. 254c-15(c)(8)) is amended by inserting before

- 1 the period the following: ", including, as provided by the
- 2 Secretary, may use funds to provide to military veterans
- 3 required coursework and training that take into account,
- 4 and are not duplicative of, previous medical coursework
- 5 and training received when such veterans were active
- 6 members of the Armed Forces, to enable such veterans
- 7 to satisfy emergency medical services personnel certifi-
- 8 cation requirements, as determined by the appropriate
- 9 State regulatory entity".
