A BILL

To repeal the renewable fuel standard.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Renewable Fuel Stand-
5 ard Repeal Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF RENEWABLE FUEL STANDARD.**

7 Section 211 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7545)
8 is amended by striking subsection (o).

1 **SEC. 3. ADDITIONAL REPEAL.**

2 Section 204 of the Energy Independence and Security
3 Act of 2007 (42 U.S.C. 7545 note; Public Law 110–140)
4 is repealed.

5 **SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.**

6 Beginning on the date of enactment of this Act, the
7 regulations under subparts K and M of part 80 of title
8 40, Code of Federal Regulations (as in effect on that date
9 of enactment), shall have no force or effect.
