3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Broadband Buildout
5 Accountability Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY OF FOIA TO THE BROADBAND EQ-**
2 **UITY, ACCESS, AND DEPLOYMENT PROGRAM.**
