A BILL

To help ensure that all items offered for sale in any gift shop of the National Park Service or of the National Archives and Records Administration are produced in the United States, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Parks Amer-
5 ican Products Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIRING THAT ITEMS SOLD IN CERTAIN FED-**
2 **ERAL GIFT SHOPS ARE PRODUCED IN THE**
3 **UNITED STATES.**

4 (a) NATIONAL PARK SERVICE.—The Secretary of the
5 Interior shall ensure that all items offered for sale in any
6 gift shop or visitor’s center located within a unit of the
7 National Park System are produced in the United States.

8 (b) NATIONAL ARCHIVES AND RECORDS ADMINIS-
9 TRATION.—The Archivist of the United States shall en-
10 sure that all items offered for sale in any gift shop of the
11 National Archives and Records Administration are pro-
12 duced in the United States.
