## A BILL

To pay personnel compensation and benefits for employees  
of the Federal Aviation Administration.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Aviation Em-  
5 ployees Protection Act of 2011”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR PERSONNEL COSTS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 9502(d)(1) of the Inter-  
8 nal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

9 (1) by striking “before July 23, 2011,”;

1           (2) in subparagraph (A), by inserting “before  
2       July 23, 2011,” after “incurred”;

3           (3) in subparagraph (B)—

4                 (A) by striking “heretofore or hereafter”  
5       and inserting “before July 23, 2011,” after “in-  
6       curred”; and

7                 (B) by striking “or” at the end of clause  
8       (iv);

9           (4) in subparagraph (C), by striking “.” and in-  
10       serting “; or”; and

11          (5) by adding at the end the following:

12                 “(D) incurred under the Federal Aviation  
13       Employees Protection Act of 2011.”.

14          (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by  
15       this section shall take effect on July 23, 2011.

16       **SEC. 3. USE OF TRUST FUND.**

17       Notwithstanding the expiration of section 48103(8)  
18       of title 49, United States Code, amounts in the Airport  
19       and Airway Trust Fund shall be available to pay personnel  
20       compensation and benefits for employees of the Federal  
21       Aviation Administration funded from appropriations or  
22       authorizations provided on or before July 22, 2011.
