A BILL

To designate United States Route 20 in the States of Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, Nebraska, Iowa, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Pennsylvania, New York, and Massachusetts as the “National Medal of Honor Highway”, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATIONAL MEDAL OF HONOR HIGHWAY.**

4 (a) PURPOSE.—The purposes of this Act are—

5 (1) to honor all current and future Medal of
6 Honor recipients; and

1 (2) to recognize the valor and service of those
2 Medal of Honor recipients.

3 (b) DESIGNATION.—United States Route 20 in each
4 of the States of Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, Ne-
5 braska, Iowa, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Pennsylvania, New
6 York, and Massachusetts shall be known and designated
7 as the “National Medal of Honor Highway”.

8 (c) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
10 States to the highway referred to in subsection (b) shall
11 be deemed to be a reference to the “National Medal of
12 Honor Highway”.
