## A BILL

To prohibit the regulation of carbon dioxide emissions in the United States until China, India, and Russia implement similar reductions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CARBON DIOXIDE REDUCTIONS IN CHINA,**  
4 **INDIA, AND RUSSIA.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Ad-  
6 ministrator of the Environmental Protection Agency or  
7 the head of any other Federal agency shall not regulate  
8 carbon dioxide emissions until the date on which the Sec-  
9 retary of Commerce certifies in writing that each of the  
10 People's Republic of China, the Republic of India, and

1 Russia have initiated measures that require carbon dioxide  
2 emission reductions that are substantially similar to the  
3 carbon dioxide emission reductions proposed for the  
4 United States.
