A BILL

To provide for the compensation of furloughed Federal employees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Employee Ret-
5 roactive Pay Fairness Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMPENSATION FOR FURLOUGHED FEDERAL EM-**
7 **PLOYEES.**

8 Federal employees furloughed as a result of any lapse
9 in appropriations which begins on or about October 1,

1 2013, shall be compensated at their standard rate of com-
2 pensation, for the period of such lapse in appropriations,
3 as soon as practicable after such lapse in appropriations
4 ends.
