Mr. DAINES introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To require a report on the location of C-130 Modular Airborne Firefighting System units.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPORT ON THE LOCATION OF C-130 MODULAR**

4 **AIRBORNE FIREFIGHTING SYSTEM UNITS.**

5 Not later than September 30, 2016, the Secretary of
6 the Air Force shall submit to Congress a report setting
7 forth an assessment of the locations of C-130 Modular
8 Airborne Firefighting System (MAFFS) units. The report
9 shall include the following:

1 (1) A list of the C-130 Modular Airborne Fire-
2 fighting System units of the Air Force.

3 (2) The utilization rates of the units listed
4 under paragraph (1).

5 (3) A future force allocation determination with
6 respect to such units in order to achieve the most ef-
7 ficient use of such units.

8 (4) An assessment of the feasibility and advis-
9 ability of modifications to the C-130 Modular Air-
10 borne Firefighting System program to enhance fire-
11 fighting capabilities.

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
