1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

**3** SECTION 1. CERTAIN RAYON STAPLE FIBERS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.55.04 of the Har5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amend6 ed—

7 (1) by striking the date in the effective period
8 column and inserting "12/31/2012"; and

9 (2) by striking "Free" in the column 1 general
10 rate of duty column and inserting "1.9%".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 this section apply with respect to goods entered, or with drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the
 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
