A BILL

To amend title 36, United States Code, to grant a Federal charter to the American Military Retirees Association, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. GRANT OF FEDERAL CHARTER TO AMERICAN
- 4 MILITARY RETIREES ASSOCIATION.
- 5 (a) Grant of Charter.—Part B of subtitle II of
- 6 title 36, United States Code, is amended by inserting after
- 7 chapter 1405 the following new chapter:
- 8 "CHAPTER 1406—AMERICAN MILITARY
- 9 **RETIREES ASSOCIATION**

- "140602. Purposes.
- "140603. Membership.
- "140604. Governing body.
- "140605. Powers.
- "140606. Restrictions.
- "140607. Tax-exempt status required as condition of charter.
- "140608. Records and inspection.
- "140609. Service of process.
- "140610. Liability for acts of officers and agents.

1 **"§ 140601. Organization**

- 2 "(a) Federal Charter.—American Military Retir-
- 3 ees Association (in this chapter, the 'corporation'), a non-
- 4 profit organization that meets the requirements for a vet-
- 5 erans service organization under section 501(c)(19) of the
- 6 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and is organized under
- 7 the laws of the State of New York, is a federally chartered
- 8 corporation.
- 9 "(b) Expiration of Charter.—If the corporation
- 10 does not comply with the provisions of this chapter, the
- 11 charter granted by subsection (a) shall expire.

12 **"§ 140602. Purposes**

- 13 "(a) General.—The purposes of the corporation are
- 14 as provided in its bylaws and articles of incorporation and
- 15 include—
- 16 "(1) encouraging military retirees to band to-
- gether to protect earned benefits by educating on
- benefits available; and
- 19 "(2) advocating for the protection of earned
- benefits through active monitoring of legislation in

- 1 Congress and the policies and proposals of the De-
- 2 partment of Defense and the Department of Vet-
- 3 erans Affairs.

4 "§ 140603. Membership

- 5 "Eligibility for membership in the corporation, and
- 6 the rights and privileges of members of the corporation,
- 7 are as provided in the bylaws of the corporation.

8 **"§ 140604. Governing body**

- 9 "(a) Board of Directors.—The composition of the
- 10 board of directors of the corporation, and the responsibil-
- 11 ities of the board, are as provided in the articles of incor-
- 12 poration and bylaws of the corporation.
- 13 "(b) Officers.—The positions of officers of the cor-
- 14 poration, and the election of the officers, are as provided
- 15 in the articles of incorporation and bylaws.

16 **"§ 140605. Powers**

- 17 "The corporation has only those powers provided in
- 18 its bylaws and articles of incorporation filed in each State
- 19 in which it is incorporated.

20 **"§ 140606. Restrictions**

- 21 "(a) Stock and Dividends.—The corporation may
- 22 not issue stock or declare or pay a dividend.
- 23 "(b) Distribution of Income or Assets.—The in-
- 24 come or assets of the corporation may not inure to the
- 25 benefit of, or be distributed to, a director, officer, or mem-

- 1 ber of the corporation during the life of the charter grant-
- 2 ed by this chapter. This subsection does not prevent the
- 3 payment of reasonable compensation to an officer or em-
- 4 ployee of the corporation or reimbursement for actual nec-
- 5 essary expenses in amounts approved by the board of di-
- 6 rectors.
- 7 "(c) Loans.—The corporation may not make a loan
- 8 to a director, officer, employee, or member of the corpora-
- 9 tion.
- 10 "(d) Claim of Governmental Approval or Au-
- 11 THORITY.—The corporation may not claim congressional
- 12 approval or the authority of the United States Govern-
- 13 ment for any of its activities.
- 14 "(e) Corporate Status.—The corporation shall
- 15 maintain its status as a corporation incorporated under
- 16 the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- 17 "§ 140607. Tax-exempt status required as condition of
- 18 charter
- 19 "If the corporation fails to maintain its status as an
- 20 organization exempt from taxation under the Internal
- 21 Revenue Code of 1986, the charter granted under this
- 22 chapter shall terminate.
- 23 "§ 140608. Records and inspection
- 24 "(a) Records.—The corporation shall keep—
- 25 "(1) correct and complete records of account;

- 1 "(2) minutes of the proceedings of the mem-
- 2 bers, board of directors, and committees of the cor-
- 3 poration having any of the authority of the board of
- 4 directors of the corporation; and
- 5 "(3) at the principal office of the corporation,
- 6 a record of the names and addresses of the members
- 7 of the corporation entitled to vote on matters relat-
- 8 ing to the corporation.
- 9 "(b) Inspection.—A member entitled to vote on any
- 10 matter relating to the corporation, or an agent or attorney
- 11 of the member, may inspect the records of the corporation
- 12 for any proper purpose at any reasonable time.

13 **"§ 140609. Service of process**

- 14 "The corporation shall comply with the law on service
- 15 of process of each State in which it is incorporated and
- 16 each State in which it carries on activities.

17 "§ 140610. Liability for acts of officers and agents

- 18 "The corporation is liable for any act of any officer
- 19 or agent of the corporation acting within the scope of the
- 20 authority of the corporation.

21 **"§ 140611. Annual report**

- 22 "The corporation shall submit to Congress an annual
- 23 report on the activities of the corporation during the pre-
- 24 ceding fiscal year. The report shall be submitted at the
- 25 same time as the report of the audit required by section

- 1 10101(b) of this title. The report may not be printed as
- 2 a public document.

3 "§ 140612. Definition

- 4 "In this chapter, the term 'State' includes the Dis-
- 5 trict of Columbia and the territories and possessions of
- 6 the United States.".
- 7 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of chapters
- 8 at the beginning of subtitle II of title 36, United States
- 9 Code, is amended by inserting after the item relating to
- 10 chapter 1405 the following new item:
