- 4 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.70.19 of the Har-
- 5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amend-
- 6 ed—
- 7 (1) by striking "approximately .0125 inches
- 8 thick" and inserting "that are approximately 0.40
- 9 millimeters to 1.65 millimeters thick"; and

- 1 (2) by striking the date in the effective period 2 column and inserting "12/31/2011".
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 4 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 5 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 6 the date of the enactment of this Act.
