## A BILL

To amend the Trade Facilitation and Trade Enforcement Act of 2015 to modify the description of interest for purposes of certain distributions of antidumping duties and countervailing duties, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “China Trade Cheating  
5 Restitution Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF DESCRIPTION OF INTEREST FOR**  
2 **PURPOSES OF CERTAIN DISTRIBUTIONS OF**  
3 **ANTIDUMPING DUTIES AND COUNTER-**  
4 **VAILING DUTIES.**

5 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 605(c)(1) of the Trade  
6 Facilitation and Trade Enforcement Act of 2015 (19  
7 U.S.C. 4401(c)(1)) is amended—

8 (1) by striking subparagraphs (A) and (B); and

9 (2) by striking “October 1, 2014, by U.S. Cus-  
10 toms and Border Protection under, or in connection  
11 with—” and inserting “October 1, 2000, by U.S.  
12 Customs and Border Protection.”.

13 (b) **FUNDING.**—In carrying out the amendments  
14 made by subsection (a), the Commissioner of U.S. Cus-  
15 toms and Border Protection may use amounts available  
16 in the “Refund of Moneys Erroneously Received and Cov-  
17 ered” account of the Department of the Treasury.
