## A BILL

To allow States to waive regulations promulgated under the Clean Air Act relating to electric generating units under certain circumstances.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF CERTAIN REGULATIONS PROMUL-**  
4 **GATED UNDER THE CLEAN AIR ACT.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a State  
6 may permanently waive any regulation relating to electric  
7 generating units promulgated by the Administrator of the  
8 Environmental Protection Agency under the Clean Air Act  
9 (42 U.S.C. 7401 et seq.) if the Governor of the State cer-

- 1 tifies that the electric generating units are necessary for
- 2 reasons of power reliability and affordability.
