3 **SECTION 1. EXCLUDING CITIZENSHIP DATA FROM PUBLIC**

4 **LAW 94–171 REDISTRICTING DATA.**

5 Section 141(c) of title 13, United States Code, is
6 amended by adding at the end the following: “The Sec-
7 retary may not include any information regarding United
8 States citizenship in a tabulation of population reported
9 or transmitted under the preceding sentence.”.
