3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “CDC Accountability
5 Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. APPOINTMENT AND AUTHORITY OF THE DIRECTOR**
2 **OF THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL**
3 **AND PREVENTION.**

4 Section 2101(b) of the Prepare for and Respond to
5 Existing Viruses, Emerging New Threats, and Pandemics
6 Act (Public Law 117–328) is amended by striking “Janu-
7 ary 20, 2025” and inserting “the date of enactment of
8 the CDC Accountability Act of 2023”.
