3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bolts Ditch Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL ENTITIES AUTHORIZED TO MAINTAIN**
2 **BOLTS DITCH AND THE BOLTS DITCH**
3 **HEADGATE.**

4 Section 1101(a) of the John D. Dingell, Jr. Con-
5 servation, Management, and Recreation Act (Public Law
6 116–9; 133 Stat. 604) is amended by inserting before the
7 period at the end the following: “, the Eagle River Water
8 and Sanitation District, a Colorado Special District, or the
9 Upper Eagle Regional Water Authority, an authority or-
10 ganized under the laws of the State of Colorado”.
