A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to repeal the deduction for local lobbying expenses.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF DEDUCTION FOR LOCAL LOBBYING**

4 **EXPENSES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 162(e) of the Internal
6 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking paragraphs
7 (2) and (7) and by redesignating paragraphs (3), (4), (5),
8 (6), and (8) as paragraphs (2), (3), (4), (5), and (6), re-
9 spectively.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
2 6033(e)(1)(B)(ii) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
3 is amended by striking “section 162(e)(5)(B)(ii)” and in-
4 serting “section 162(e)(4)(B)(ii)”.

5 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
6 this section shall apply to amounts paid or incurred after
7 December 31, 2017.

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
