## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to address the receipt of grant funds by employees of the United States Naval Academy, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RECEIPT OF GRANT FUNDS BY UNITED STATES**

4 **NAVAL ACADEMY EMPLOYEES.**

5 Section 8452 of title 10, United States Code, is  
6 amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subsection (d) as sub-  
8 section (e); and

1           (2) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-  
2           lowing new subsection (d):

3           “(d) Notwithstanding section 5533 of title 5, employ-  
4           ees of the Naval Academy who are on leave without pay,  
5           due to the regular 10-month pay schedule and not due  
6           to discipline or other reasons, are eligible to receive funds,  
7           including for salary and fringe benefit payments, from  
8           grant funds provided by Federal agencies other than the  
9           Naval Academy, including the National Institutes of  
10          Health, the National Science Foundation, the Office of  
11          Naval Research, the Department of Energy, and the Na-  
12          tional Aeronautics and Space Administration.”.
