A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to modify the per-fiscal year calculation of days of certain active duty or active service used to reduce the minimum age at which a member of a reserve component of the uniformed services may retire for non-regular service.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Reserve Retirement
5 Deployment Credit Correction Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF PER-FISCAL YEAR CALCULATION**
2 **OF DAYS OF CERTAIN ACTIVE DUTY OR AC-**
3 **TIVE SERVICE TO REDUCE ELIGIBILITY AGE**
4 **FOR RETIREMENT FOR NON-REGULAR SERV-**
5 **ICE.**

6 (a) ACCUMULATION OF 90-DAY PERIODS OF SERV-
7 ICE WITHIN ANY TWO CONSECUTIVE FISCAL YEARS.—
8 Section 12731(f)(2)(A) of title 10, United States Code,
9 is amended by striking “in any fiscal year” and inserting
10 “in any two consecutive fiscal years”.

11 (b) RETROACTIVE EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amend-
12 ment made by subsection (a) shall take effect as of Janu-
13 ary 28, 2008, and as if included in the National Defense
14 Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2008 (Public Law 110–
15 181) as enacted.

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
