2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXCLUSION OF AIR EMISSIONS FROM ANIMALS**
2 **WASTE AT FARMS FROM EMERGENCY NOTIFI-**
3 **CATION REQUIREMENTS.**

4 Section 304(a)(4) of the Emergency Planning and
5 Community Right-To-Know Act of 1986 (42 U.S.C.
6 11004(a)(4)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking the period at the end and insert-
8 ing “; or”;

9 (2) by striking “release which” and inserting
10 the following: “release—

11 “(A) that”; and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following:

13 “(B) of air emissions from animal waste
14 (as defined in section 103(e)(2) of CERCLA
15 (42 U.S.C. 9603(e)(2)) (including decomposing
16 animal waste) at a farm (as defined in that sec-
17 tion).”.
