A BILL

To amend section 875(c) of title 18, United States Code, to include an intent requirement.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Interstate Threats
5 Clarification Act of 2016”.

6 **SEC. 2. INTERSTATE COMMUNICATIONS.**

7 Section 875(e) of title 18, United States Code, is
8 amended—

9 (a) by inserting “(1)” before “Whoever”;

1 (b) in paragraph (1), as so designated, by striking
2 “in interstate or foreign commerce” and inserting “, using
3 the mail or any facility or means of interstate or foreign
4 commerce,”; and

5 (c) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(2) For purposes of an offense under this sub-
7 section, the Government shall prove that the defendant in-
8 tended, had knowledge, or recklessly disregarded the risk,
9 that the communication would be reasonably interpreted
10 as a threat.”.
