1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. ARTICHOKES, PREPARED OR PRESERVED BY 4 VINEGAR OR ACETIC ACID.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.90 of the Har-6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to 7 artichokes, prepared or preserved by vinegar or acetic 8 acid) is amended by striking the date in the effective pe-9 riod column and inserting "12/31/2015". (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
