A BILL

To require the termination of any employee of the Department of Veterans Affairs who is found to have retaliated against a whistleblower.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF EMPLOYEES OF THE DE-**
4 **PARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS WHO RE-**
5 **TALIATE AGAINST WHISTLEBLOWERS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to chapter 12 of title 5,
7 United States Code, including the right of an employee
8 to obtain judicial review under section 1215(a)(4) of that
9 title, and notwithstanding any other provision of law, any
10 employee of the Department of Veterans Affairs who is

1 determined under section 1215 of that title to have vio-
2 lated paragraph (8), (9), or (13) of section 2302(b) of that
3 title shall be terminated.

4 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall apply to an
5 act committed before, on, or after the date of enactment
6 of this Act.

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
