A BILL

To repeal the exception to sanctions with respect to the energy, shipping, and shipbuilding sectors of Iran relating to reconstruction assistance for Afghanistan.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Harbor for Terror
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF EXCEPTION TO SANCTIONS WITH RE-**
2 **SPECT TO ENERGY, SHIPPING, AND SHIP-**
3 **BUILDING SECTORS OF IRAN RELATING TO**
4 **AFGHANISTAN RECONSTRUCTION.**

5 Subsection (f) of section 1244 of the Iran Freedom
6 and Counter-Proliferation Act of 2012 (22 U.S.C. 8803)
7 is repealed.
